Silverspring Community Association (SCA) Soccer Registration FAQs

Outdoor Session May 4 – June 26, 2026

1. What are the age groups, prices, and nights of play?

Age Group	Year of Birth	Fees	# of games/practices	Tentative Night of play

2. When does SCA soccer registration take place and how do I register my child?

Kindersoccer and U5 Soccer registration is from February 1, 2026 – April 12, 2026. You can register online at www.silverspringcommunity.ca. Registrations require a valid SCA membership (July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026), and this membership is non-refundable.

3. What if my child is older than Kindersoccer and U5 Soccer and wants to play?

Please register with Willowgrove University Heights Community Association (WUHCA) this season for outdoor soccer.

4. What if my child's year of birth is 2016 or earlier?

Your child should be enrolled in Youth Soccer through our zone (Hollandia Soccer). See www.hollandiasoccer.ca and www.saskatoonyouthsoccer.ca.

5. What equipment do players need?

Running shoes and comfortable clothes are fine. Shin guards are recommended for U5. If shin guards are worn, they must be covered to prevent injury to other players. Team shirts and soccer balls are provided.

6. Can I coach? What training do I need to coach?

Yes! We are always in need of coaches. In fact, if a parent on your child's team does not step up to coach, we will have to refund the fees paid and your child will not be able to play.

7. If I decide I want to volunteer to be a coach and take the coach certification requirements, does SCA reimburse me for the courses?

Yes. You will be fully refunded for the above required courses taken.

8. I can't coach – how else can I help?

You can help your team as manager if needed. Another option is to consider signing up as a soccer coordinator for next year. Contact anyone on the SCA board if you are interested!

9. Is there an in-person registration night?

No, there will not be in-person registration.

10. Do I need to buy a new membership?

You will need a current family SCA membership. Memberships are valid from July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026. Memberships can be purchased online at the time of registration. Your child cannot play without a valid membership.

11. How do I get a membership card?

There are no membership cards. Your email registration receipt is proof of your membership. Please keep this in your records for future reference.

12. Are spots limited?

No, there is no registration limit. If we don't get enough coaches to volunteer, some players will not be able to play and will be refunded.

13. Can I get a refund?

There will be no refunds issued, except in the case of not enough coach volunteers.

14. When will I get team information?

Your coach should email you by mid-April. If you don't receive an email by April 20, email SCA soccer coordinator below.
